The 12 Fields of Rocks

Sometimes we feel that people who get a new Rock – or are confronting an old one – require some guidance and extra help. It is good to forage in the dark a little, but also people need more help. Thus we have managed to describe 12 types of Rocks. Most Rocks fall into these categories.

If you have some idea of what category your Rock is in, you have a suggestion of a pathway to tread to relieve yourself of that Rock.


These categories are not necessarily exclusive. Some Rocks may fall into more than one category. Also, although we refer to Rocks, it is true that Zeros and Absents can often fall into one or more of these categories.

Etherically, you can visit these Fields of Rocks, where little rock-clusters exist! State clearly before

you journey, which Field you want to visit to see your Rock.

Let the Fields of Rocks be a place of play, to help you soar above 'yourself' and your own limited (and limiting) persona. You are Light, beyond.

The mind has created the Rocks and tremendous consciousness and awareness can dissolve them – with laughter, with grace in the Fields of Play.



1. The Karmic Rock

Some past life action, or even some future life action which your patterns show that you will commit, is indicated in the Rock.

In some way, a karmic situation needs to be resolved – and when it is resolved the Rock will be lifted.

Understanding and penetration to the heart of a here-now situation is required. The situation has been created by the 'karma' of the past, or 'future karma' – which happens when ripples from a future life or existence demand some energy input from this present life.

Karma can be dragged out interminably by not *understanding the reason behind it* – the cause for the karma in the first place, the source of the

karma. Is it of a past life or this life – or even a 'future existence'? What actions in past lives have led to that karma?

For the evolved soul, most karma is like a sample. One only needs to taste it a little and *if one understands the actions that have led to that karma*, then you are more quickly free to soar beyond. It is a risk – this determination to understand – an enormous leap; but this risk generates the huge power and momentum needed to clear your karma.

Once you have accepted the so-called 'lesson' of that karma – what depth of insight or teaching that karma is trying to awaken – then you are more quickly released!

Karma is like a churning mill-wheel. You have to endure it and to focus upon it, understand its source; but you also have to let it be, let it take its natural course. When the understanding is reached, the karma moves to clear itself. The Rock is lifted.

2. The Enlightenment Rock

Sometimes you have chosen to delve more deeply into a colour, because it is important for your 'enlightenment'. This happens in the days before Enlightenment – but remember we are talking here about 'cosmic days'.

The individual seeks to discover some aspect of himself or herself that will be a *bridge* to the enlightened self, a way, a path to follow. This Rock is a bridge to enlightenment.



3. The Energy Rock

A block in your energy has come up, because the Divine Existence is pushing this energy through more and more. The Existence sees that this colour or this facet of yourself has not been fully enough explored and it presses (or imprints) this energy on to you. But instead of flowing with it, you have repressed it.

Even if they have been cracked, Energy Rocks often become 'rocked' again a little later down the line, so be aware of them.



4. The Queen Rock

Sometimes a Rock happens because, out of some measure of laziness, you have not protected this colour well. It has become corrupted with vibrations from other spheres, which are negative in nature. All colours which flow through you need protecting, nurturing so that they can come to a flowering. The Queen Rock is the laziness Rock, which happens because you need to become more aware of the vibrations which may affect you.



5. The Incandescent Rock

Light is incandescent and as you grow and move, you become more and more concentrated into Light. This Rock shows you have a resistance to the 'Holy Light', that you would rather stay safe and warm with the familiar, rather than stepping into the Great Unknown. There is nothing wrong in this; but this Rock indicates that it is time to move with this aspect of yourself, so that the Great Light can enter you.



6. The Mercenary Rock

Sometimes a Rock happens because you are playing out some role for another. You have become self-sacrificial and this Rock has developed because of your concern for others. Your energy has been moving towards others, but if it creates a Rock in yourself, then something of the purpose is defeated. You become a mercenary for another person's karma. There is no judgement on this; it is for you to decide if you want to move this way.



7. The Challenge Rock

Sometimes a soul becomes bored! In that case, you (your higher self) invent a Rock, because you want to be challenged. It is not that your energy is thwarted, so much as you require on a deep soul-level to move with a colour and the energy of that colour, as a deeper and more real exploration. You may be fine on this colour, but you have decided to go for A++ rather than straight A! Your soul is captivated by this colour and you need to delve deeply and explore it to the maximum. The challenge of your soul is to find this colour, this energy, even more deeply within yourself.



8. The Plastic Rock

Sometimes you have fake Rocks. These are Rocks that are not deeply embedded, but you have chosen to carry them out of some martyr complex! Perhaps you feel the need to punish yourself by carrying the load of this Rock. Understand that self-punishment is crazy and useless and has no use on the enlightenment path. Your beauty is that you have the talent to see!

The plastic Rock is a fake Rock, because you can choose to drop it at any time and you do not need to wander into the wilderness, as so many do with this Rock, getting confused and stupid! You are not stupid! But the fake Rock needs to be dropped.



9. The Boring Rock

The Boring Rock is the Rock whereby you bore more deeply into self and the traumas of the past which have inhabited (and inhibited) you. We do not always consider exploration into the past to be worthwhile. It takes a wise man or woman to know when it is appropriate or when it is not.

But on this occasion, with this Rock, it is wise to move into the past and bore deeply into the traumatized self. It is time to explore some wound or trauma of self, and that is why you have this Rock. When you have bored deeply enough, the Rock will dissolve and you will breathe fresh air once again!



10. The Masonic Rock

Sometimes a Rock happens because you have been part of a mystic circle in the past and as a result of that participation, something strange and disorientating has arisen within your soul. You have set in motion, in the past, some energy, some vibration, which is just hitting you now. You have matured and developed in so many ways, but these Rocks are like an arrow from the past. It is something you have to deal with.

It is not exactly a 'karma', but it is an action of some Masonic sequence which requires you to open up to life in a different way. You have programmed this Rock yourself, strangely, in many years or lifetimes past. You receive the consequences of your actions. Thus you need to examine the arrow that has hit you here; what is it? What is going on? What is it in your life that needs to be examined? What needs to be purged or cleansed, within yourself?

11. The Light-worker's Rock

Acry goes out to Light-helpers and sometimes, simply, you resist. This Rock is an example and a proof of that resistance. You do not hear the Existence's call. You are fried perhaps, or some other tasks have distracted you. You are not alert enough to hear the Existence's call.

You cannot have arrived at some 'enlightenment' state where you don't need to be part of the Existence's dance. If you claim this, then you are deceiving yourself, because the very essence of 'enlightenment' is that you have become one with the Existence's dance!

The Existence is asking you and in some cases *begging* you to come on board! You are not coming on board, because of a deep-rooted resistance within you and that is reflected within this Rock.

12. The Leaping Rock

You are unconscious of something and need a slap in the face! This is the Zen Rock, the Rock of the wake-up stick. You go round in something of a daze and this colour is the colour you need awakening. What stupid and foolish things are you doing, thinking, saying, out of your unconsciousness and perhaps barbaric haze? Or is it that you are fixed and have a mindset rigid in a certain way? Ask your friends how they experience it manifesting in you!



Sometimes the energy is so immense, so vast, so troublesome that you want to hide! The energy is showering upon you and yet you choose to be concealed. You do not come out into the open and celebrate the Light. You stay hidden, 'safe', out of touch with the here-now pulse. You can jump into the vastness and this Rock suggests *a way you can jump*. It is a jumping-off point into the Eternal. By exploring and moving with this colour, you can sing in the Existence's rain! In this showering, you can become one with the Godhead.

But you are shallow perhaps, or undecided, or reluctant. This beautiful colour, which could become a leaping-point for the Beyond, becomes a Rock and very often it stays one. The energy congeals, because you have not used this Ray as a jumping-point. You need consciousness with this colour, otherwise the Rock – instead of being a leaping-point – can consume you and wreck your daily life.
